cooking time from: 25 minutes

method

Preheat the oven to 180°C for fan-assisted or 200°C for ovens without a fan (gas 6).

Place the giant pig in a blanket onto a roasting tray.

Roast for approximately 35 minutes until the bacon is crisp and caramelised and the sausages are thoroughly cooked.

Alternatively, air fry 200°C for 25 minutes until the bacon is crisp and caramelised and the sausagemeat is thoroughly cooked.

Serve with your festive roast, or pass around as a pre dinner snack.
