cooking time from: 12 minutes

method

Preheat the oven to 200°C for fan-assisted or 220°C for ovens without a fan (gas 7).

Place the stuffing onto a roasting tray and cook for 25 minutes until crisp and caramelised on top, and piping hot in the centre reaching a core temperature of 75°C.

Alternatively, air fry 12 to 15 minutes on 200°C.
